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Precautions before Use: Warning (Room Configuration & Use):

- Proper Electrical Grounding is Required
- Electrical Receptacles not Allowed in the Room
- Do not Apply Water to any Heating Element
- Do not Add a Locking or Latching System to the Door
- Do not Block Ventilation Openings
- Children Must be Supervised at all Times in the Sauna

Installation Requirements

- 1. Do not plug any other appliances into the outlet with your infrared sauna.
- 2. The cabin must be erected on a level surface. A distance of at least 5cm from the wall must be maintained.
- 3. Do not spray the exterior with water. If the floor is damp, install a floor separator to keep the sauna high & dry.
- 4. Do not store flammable objects or chemical substances near the sauna.
- 5. The sauna must be placed indoors and in a dry area. Moisture will cause damage to the interior and exterior of the sauna.
- 6. Installation and connection of the electrical parts (control unit, heater, etc.) may only be performed when the power supply is disconnected.
- 7. Comply with the regulations applicable at the installation location.
- 8. We do not recommend using an extension cord for your sauna. Please plug the sauna directly into the wall receptacle.
- 9. For your own safety, consult your supplier in the event of problems that are not explained in sufficient detail in the installation instructions.


Assembly Instructions

Assembly of the sauna requires at least 2 adults to complete. Please read the instructions thoroughly before and during assembly to ensure proper installation of the sauna.



Step 1: Location of the sauna


- When selecting the location for your sauna, please ensure the main power cord on the sauna is easily accessible.
- The location must be on level ground and dry.



Step 2: Place the base/floor panel

• Start by placing the floor panel close to the desired end location. You will need to leave space around each side for access.

Step 3: Install the glass front panel and door (Panel #1)



• Align the wooden left side panels with glass front panels' corresponding inside-buckles.

* For the Sahara LSS-1 you will not have the left side panels and continue to step 4

• Please take care of the glass door to avoid damage. Make sure the insidebuckles on both side panels are fixed in place.

• Use the metal bracket to connect the top of wooden left side panels with glass front panels tightly. Fix the metal bracket by screws (3*20 mm) to make sure it is stable enough.







Step 4: Install the left side panel (Panel # 2)

- Align the left side panels with front panel's corresponding outside-buckles.
- Make sure the outside-buckles on both side panels are fixed in place.




Outside buckles



Step 5: Install the rear panel(Panel # 3)


• Align the left side panels with rear panel's corresponding outside buckles.


• Make sure the outside- buckles on both side panels are fixed in place.



Step 6: Install the bench heater:

- Slide down the bench heater panel by lining up its sides with the vertical guides on side panel.
- The heater grill is facing outward (toward the front of the sauna).
- Push the bench heater panel all the way down until it is touching the bottom panel and securely in place.





Step 8: Install the bench

- Position the bench by smoothly gliding it along the horizontal bench guides located on the side panels.
- Carefully advance the bench until it contacts the back panel, ensuring a secure fit.
- Affix the bench firmly using two screws measuring 4*40mm after installing the right-side panel.

Step 9: Install the right-side panel (Panel # 4)

- Align the right-side panels with rear panel's corresponding outside-buckles.
- Make sure the outside-buckles on both side panels are fixed in place.





Step 7: Connect bench heater wires

Connect the wire of bench heater to the back panel.



Step 10: Install the top panel (ceiling)

- Lower the roof panel on to the assembled panels.
- Gently place the top panel on to the rest of the assembled panels.

• When four corners are in place, gently push down the roof panel from the outside corners until it is snugly fit over the rest of panels.

• Make sure the cables do not get pinched between the panels.

• Leading the wires of heaters on to the board through the corresponding hole.

• Fix the roof panels by screws (4*40mm) to make sure it is stable enough.



Step 11: Connect the main power on the top panel

- Connect all the wires for heaters.
- Connect the control panel wires (CTRL).
- Check if all connections to the control box are secure.



Step 12: Place roof cover on top of the roof panel

Place the roof cover onto the roof panel, connect it to the roof panel with the screws (3*20mm).



Step 13: Install the door knob



Step 14: Enjoy your sauna!

- Plug in the main power cord into the wall outlet and power up your sauna.
- Turn on the Bluetooth, grab some towels, a glass of water and step into your sauna and enjoy the benefits!

Recommendations for Use:

- Avoid eating large meals and excessive alcohol intake before using Sauna.
- Never smoke, drink alcohol or exercise inside of Sauna.

• If you are taking any medications or under the care of a physician, consult with them prior to Sauna usage. Refer to Sauna Usage Warning signs located inside of Sauna Room.

• Prior to Sauna session, if possible take a warm shower. Make sure to dry off thoroughly before going into the sauna because excessive water will stain or warp the wood.

• Clothing is optional or wear loose fitting clothes. You may choose to sit or lie on a clean, soft towel.

• Set desired time & temperature.

• The Sauna is producing the correct wavelengths to be absorbed into the body within 10-15 minutes of operation. It is not necessary to wait unit the sauna is at maximum temperature; the absorption of wavelength is the same whether the room is in heat up or at set temperature.

• Enter Sauna and relax, you may choose to enjoy music. Refer to the above Color Therapy System instructions.

• Sit or lie on bench. Close the door and the interior ceiling vent allowing the sauna to heat up faster. To allow more ventilation you can open the vent if needed.

• Remain in the Sauna long enough to warm up and stimulate a mild perspiration. Typically, that may occur in 10 – 15 minutes. This varies with every individual and their comfort level. Do not over do it!

- Drink plenty of cool water or a refreshing healthy drink while using the sauna.
- Leave the Sauna and cool down. Shower or bathe if possible, to cool down and cleanse the skin.
- Cool down period usually is the same length of time as the Sauna session.
- Then re-enter the Sauna for another 10-15 minute session.
- Continue this process of alternating using the Sauna and cooling down for 3 to 4 cycles.
- Length of time in the Sauna and cool off period varies and depends on the individual.
- After final Sauna session and upon leaving the Sauna, turn the Sauna timer off if it is still operating.


• Enjoy a final shower or bath to cool down. Relax, in the special "after sauna glow" and you may choose to enjoy a healthy snack and cool drink.

Digital Control Panel Operating Instructions

Temperature Adjustment: The sauna will reach a maximum temperature of 149 Fahrenheit under ideal experimental conditions. Under normal environment temperature (77 Fahrenheit), the sauna will reach a maximum temperature anywhere from 140 to 149 Fahrenheit.



- 1. Press ON/OFF quickly to switch the sauna on to a stand-by mode.
- 2 . Set the desired temperature using up/ down arrows buttons.
- 3. Set the time to desired length using up/ down arrows buttons.
- 4. Press ON/OFF quickly a second time to activate the heaters.
- 5. When time reaches 00, all the heaters will automatically shut off.
- 6. Press and hold ON/OFF to switch the sauna off.
- 7. Pre-setting
 - "SET" switch is for pre-setting the time you want your sauna to turn on. Press "SET" switch once.
 - Pre-set the time you want your sauna to turn on with the UP/DOWN ARROWS. TEMP UP/DOWN ARROWS are for hour setting and TIME UP/DOWN ARROWS are for minute setting. The setting range is 00:00-23:59.

8. How to use Bluetooth connector for music a) Turn on your sauna, then its inside Bluetooth device would be discoverable automatically. b) For your cell phone, Turn on Bluetooth, then select add Bluetooth or other device > Bluetooth. Choose the device name"IR SAUNA", then select. Done

Maintenance & Cleaning

DO NOT USE: Alcohol or any strong cleaning chemicals Note: Some chemicals can damage clear finish and wood surfaces.

• Your sauna is made of the Natural wood. All wood products have variations in the color, grain, and may have irregularities such as knots, and fine cracks. These reflect the natural beauty of the wood and should not be considered defects.

• Before using your infrared sauna for the first time, clean the inside of the sauna with a damp cloth.

• The interior of the Infrared Sauna is made of the natural wood. It is aromatic and adds to the enjoyment of your sauna session. If the fragrance of the fresh wood is too strong during the first few months of use, first wipe the wood with a damp cloth to minimize the aroma. (*Do not use any cleaning chemicals to interior of the sauna*)

- Use furniture polish to clean the exterior. (*Do not use any cleaning chemicals to interior of the sauna*)
- We recommend placing as oft towel on the floor and on the bench of the sauna to absorb perspiration during sauna use.
- Scratches and stains on the sauna can be removed by simply using fine grade sandpaper over the damaged area.
- The cabin may not be cleaned with steam cleaners, high-pressure cleaners or splashed water.
- The wood may appear rough and hoarse caused by dampness sometimes. To smooth the affected areas, the sandpaper or gritty sponge can be used, always sanding in the direction of the grain.

• Okoume/Hemlock is a solid nature wood, minor cracks or warping might happen due to seasonal humidity changes. This is a natural process and not a defect of the material.
